To support this, a reassessment option is available under specific conditions. This process is designed to help students learn from mistakes, practice responsibility, and strengthen mastery of math skills.

Why Quality Work Matters

Students learn best when they stay on top of their assignments and give their full effort. Classwork, homework, and IXL practice provide the practice needed to prepare for assessments. Turning in quality work on time ensures students are keeping pace with the material and building the foundation necessary for success.

Criteria for Reassessment

- Complete All Unit Work: All assignments must be submitted before the original assessment date. Work should be complete, accurate, and show genuine effort.
- Finish IXL Practice: All IXL assignments connected to the unit must be completed by the original assessment date. IXL is essential for practice and building fluency.
- Return the Reassessment Request Page: Students must complete and return the Reassessment Request Page within 2 school days of the original assessment.
- Prepare for the First Assessment: Reassessments are not a substitute for studying. Students are expected to prepare for the first test. Reassessments are offered to students who have shown responsibility but still need another opportunity.

Parent & Student Reminders

- Reassessments are a privilege, not a guarantee.
- Abuse of reassessments (e.g., repeated lack of preparation for the first attempt) will result in a parent conference.
- Our goal is to help students build good study habits and show mastery through consistent effort.

This policy must be signed by a parent or guardian and returned to the teacher. Failure to return the signed policy may result in the student not being eligible for reassessments.

- If reassessments are abused (not preparing the first time), a parent conference may be scheduled.
- To reassess, this paper must be signed by a parent/guardian and returned.
